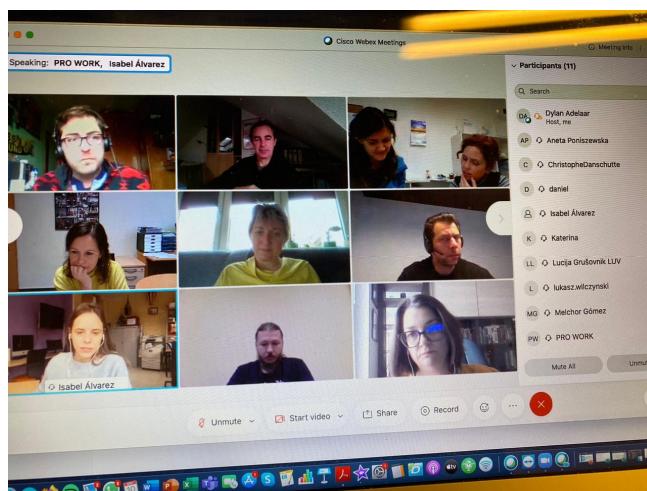
ACHIEVEMENTS SO FAR:

Despite the difficult times we are all facing, the partners are busy with meeting the set goals according to the project plan:

- Pilot tests were deployed in Slovenia, Czech Republic, Spain and the Netherlands during summer holidays and autumn term. Other partner countries begin their pilot testing in January 2021. Second round of testing will take place in March/April 2021 and the final round shall be done by July 2021.
- All 5 Moodle courses designed for teachers have been translated in all partner languages. Polish partner has developed their own courses
- All partners finalized their own educational resources such as video lessons, lesson plans, interactive resource. These resources have been translated and are now available in partners' languages
- Partners have collected existing materials and uploaded them into the Science4Fun Repository
- Handbook and guidelines are to be finalized by the the end of January 2021
- Project's website has been updated and translated into all partners languages.
