The Skills + 3.0 Project is the third one in a series of innovative projects, promoting the capacity building and the fostering of mutually beneficial relationships between people with labor disabilities and small to medium enterprises (SMEs). The project primarily seeks to enhance the employability of its target group through alternative pathways, such as competitions.

## THE COMPETITIONS

The project's primary activities include organizing eight (8) National Skills Competitions and one (1) European Competition specifically tailored for individuals with labor disabilities. Each partner country will host a National Competition, and the victorious teams from each country will compete in the European Skills Competition. Participants will have the opportunity to showcase their skills and abilities across various professions.
